I hope this letter finds you well. I am writing to give you an update on Complete Care at Summit Ridge's response to the Coronavirus.

As of 6/2/2022 at 2:00 pm

- \_ 0\_ new center staff considered Persons Under Investigation (PUI) for COVID-19.
- \_ 0\_ new residents have passed away due to COVID-19 during this pandemic.
- \_ 0\_ new center staff have passed away due to COVID-19 during this pandemic.
- 1\_ new center staff recovered from Covid 19.
- 14- residents have recovered from Covid 19.

Dear visitor: As a reminder, please do not visit if you are experiencing any cold like, covid19 or flu like symptoms. If you visit your relative in the facility and after that visit you are having signs and symptoms of covid or test positive, then please advise the facility. If you have signs or symptoms of covid -19 or test positive, then please call the nursing supervisor on duty or leave a message for me, Robert Smolin, Administrator or Lori Vida, RN, Director of Nurses, so that we can test your relative. The facility's phone number is 973-736-2000, then ask for the nursing supervisor or myself or the Director of Nurses.

We are happy to announce, that we have indoor visitation 7 days a week. We will allow visitation for residents that are on precautions for actual Covid or for exposure to Covid. A visitor could also choose not to visit until the resident has completed their 10-day quarantine time. Video and zoom meetings are available by contacting the front desk and the Activities department will set up a video session for you if you choose. Further information and policies regarding indoor visitation are available upon request.

We are following all the necessary precautions and safety measures, set by the CDC and NJDOH, in order to provide a safe environment for our residents and staff.
